DAY 2: Tuesday, February 6, 2023 | ARRIVAL TANGIER | D |

Arrival at Tangier International airport. Individual transfer to be arranged (not included). Visit Tangier Medina in the afternoon. Check-in at hotel for one night. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 3: Wednesday, February 7, 2024 | CHEFCHAOUEN | B L D |

Departure to Chefchaouen. Visit Tetouan City. Lunch in Tetouan. Visit Chefchaouen. Check-in at your hotel for one night. Overnight and dinner at the Ryad.

DAY 4: Thursday, February 8, 2024 | FEZ | B L D |

Drive to Meknes. Lunch at Domaine Zouina Winery, Visit Meknes: guided tour. Check-in at Palais Amani for 2 nights. Accommodation and dinner at Palais Amani.

DAY 5: Friday, February 9, 2024 | FEZ| B L D |

Full day sightseeing: guided tour with local guide. "Foodies" tour for lunch. Visit the Jewish guarter and the Royal Gate. Visit the tile and ceramic village. Cooking class at Palais Amani. Diner part of the cooking class

DAY 6: Saturday, February 10, 2024 | RABAT | B D |

Drive to Rabat: 130 miles / 2 ½ our drive. Drive to Rabat: Guided city tour. Time to relax before dinner. Dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 7: Sunday, February 11, 2024 | ESSAOUIRA, "THE BRIDE OF THE ATLANTIC" | B L |

Morning tour: visit the silver and wood workshops of Essaouira. Visit Domaine Val d'Argan Winery: Tour the winery and lunch. Proceed to Argan Oil cooperative and return to Essaouira. Tapas dinner at Dar Baba.

DAY 9: Tuesday, February 13, 2024 | ESSAOUIRA | B L D |

Half day excursion to the Argan forest: meet the goats in the trees. Shop for your lunch at the local souk & have it cooked at the restaurant. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner & entertainment at Caravan Cafe.

DAY 10: Wednesday, February 14, 2024 | MARRAKESH | B L D |

Check-out & drive to Marrakech. Brief orientation tour on arrival. Check-in at your hotel for 3 nights. Drive to Agafay desert for a Berbere experience: camel ride & tent dinner (20 mi / ¾ hr drive).

Guided tour of Marrakech: visit the souks and "La Sagesse" Berber pharmacy. "Foodies tour" and lunch being part of the tour. Cooking class at the Culinary Art Museum. Dinner as part of the cooking class. Visit Jemaa El Fna square.
