DAY 1: Monday, May 22, 2023 | DEPARTURE FOR BARCELONA

DAY 5: Friday, May 26, 2023 | CATALONIA: MON SANT BENET & MANRESA | B L D |

Depart Barcelona for Mon Sant Benet and Manresa. Check-in to 4* Hotel Mon Sant Benet. Pilgrim's lunch at Kursaal Restaurant in Manresa. Guided tour of the Basilica of Santa Maria de la Seu. Innovative local cooking with a chef at Hotel Mon Sant Benet followed by dinner.

DAY 6: Saturday, May 27, 2023 | VIC MARKET, SAN BENET & RAMON CASAS | B D |

Visit Vic to shop its famed Saturday market. Demo of the making of typical Catalan sausages at Casa Riera Ordeix. Visit a local farm to taste regional artisan cheeses. Monastery of St. Benet and home of Ramon Casas, Catalan artist. Dinner at Restaurant L'O, 1* Michelin.

DAY 7: Sunday, May 28, 2023 | CATALONIA: JEWISH GIRONA & SEASIDE PALAMOS | B L |

Guided walking tour of Girona focusing on its extensive Jewish history. Lunch featuring local products presented by a local chef, then free time to explore the town. After check-in to your 3* hotel in seaside Palamos, dinner will be on your own.

DAY 8: Monday, May 29, 2023 | CATALONIA: PERATALLADA VILLAGE & FISHERMEN | B L |

Explore the scenic village of Peratallada and sample unique artisan ice creams. Museu de la Pesca in Palamos with fish cooking demonstration and lunch. At 4:00 pm, observe the daily "Return of the Fishermen" and the auction of their catch. Drive to Calonge, visit the Mas Molla Winery and Fruit Farm for a wine tasting. Dinner on your own.

DAY 9: Tuesday, May 30, 2023 | CATALONIA: SALVADOR DALI DAY | B D |

Visit to the Museu de la Confitura to learn about and sample small-batch fruit preserves. Medieval Gala Castle in Pubol, summer home of Dali's wife, Gala, for many years; then tour the Dali Museum in Figueres. Continue on to Cadaques on the water with free time for lunch and stroll. Return to Palamos for our Gala Farewell Dinner.

DAY 10: Wednesday, May 31, 2023 | FAREWELL TO CATALONIA | B |

After breakfast, drive to the Barcelona Airport for flights home (*or extend your stay in Spain or France--we can help*). For those taking an evening flight, we can make arrangements for you to join a Foodie's Walking Tour of Barcelona (not included).
