

# **Andalucia Culinary & Cultural Tour with Chef Aliza Green 2024**

#### DAY 1: Saturday, January 4, 2025 | DEPARTURE |

Departure from the US for for overnight **flight to Seville** *Airfare is not included but Celestial Voyagers can help you get the best airfare and schedule.* 

#### DAY 2: Sunday, January 5, 2025 | WELCOME TO ANDALUCIA! | D |

Arrival in Seville. English-speaking assistance and group transfer on arrival is included. Check-in for three nights to your 4\* hotel, Las Casas de la Juderia. Guided walking tour of Santa Cruz and the Guadalquivir Riverbank. Welcome dinner at a local restaurant.

#### DAY 3: Monday, January 6, 2025 | EXPLORE SEVILLE AND TAPAS TASTING | B L|

Guided tour of the highlights of Seville: the Cathedral, the Giralda and the Real Alcazar. Expert guided Tapas tour and tasting in Triana for lunch. Free time to explore Seville on your own.

#### DAY 4: Tuesday, January 7, 2025 | JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA & ITS FAMOUS SHERRY | B L |

Drive to Jerez de La Frontera, about 1½ hours. Spend the day in Jerez, visit the local market and a sherry cellar. Sherry cuisine cooking demo by the chef of La Carbona Restaurant followed by lunch with sherry tasting. Return to Seville and free evening.

#### DAY 5: Wednesday, January 8, 2025 CORDOBA & ITS JEWISH HERITAGE | B L |

Depart for Cordoba to explore the influence of Islam, Judaism, and Christianity. Visit La Mezquita, the Old Town, the Alcazar de Los Reyes Cristianos and the historic Jewish quarter with guide who is expert in Cordoba's Jewish heritage. Sumptuous Sephardic lunch at Casa Mazal (House of Good Fortune) with musical performance. Check-in to the 4\* Hotel NH Amistad Cordoba for one night.

#### DAY 6: Thursday, January 9, 2025 | BAENA, ZUHEROS & PRIEGO DE CORDOBA | B L |

Depart for Baena and tour and tasting at the Olive Oil Museum. On to Zuheros, visit cheese producer, Quesería de la Sierra Subbética. Lunch at Zuhayra Restaurant featuring typical local products. Check-in to 4\* Hotel La Huerta De Las Palomas in Priego de Cordoba for one night..

#### DAY 7: Friday, January 10, 2025 | GRANADA & THE ALHAMBRA | B D |

Depart for Granada. Tour the Royal Alhambra Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the Generalife Palace. Lunch on your own. Check-in to the 4\* Hotel NH Collection Victoria for two nights, then meet for dinner at a restaurant featuring local specialties.

#### DAY 8: Saturday, January 11, 2025 | GRANADA MARKET TOUR & GYPSY FLAMENCO | B L |

Shop at the local food market, then hands-on cooking class followed by lunch. Tour the historic hammam (Islamic bathhouse) on the banks of the River Darro in the Albayzin quarter, with origins dating back to the fourteenth century and a UNESCO World Heritage site. In the evening, Gypsy-style flamenco show in a cave.

#### DAY 9: Sunday, January 12, 2025 | RONDA & MALAGA ON THE COSTA DEL SOL | B $\,$ L |

Depart for Ronda, see its famous bridge. Visit an organic winery, Cellar Joaquim Fernandez, for tour and tasting then lunch in the vineyard. Afternoon guided tour of Ronda, one of the most remarkable medieval towns in Spain. Continue to beautiful coastal Malaga, then check-in to the charming 4\* Hotel Molina Lario for two nights.

### DAY 10: Monday, January 13, 2025 | HISTORIC MALAGA & TAPAS CLASS | B L D |

Shop the local food market, tapas cooking class and lunch. Guided walking tour of historical Malaga and the Museo Picasso. Farewell Dinner at Jose Carlos Garcia, 1\* MIchelin restaurant.
